



**Section 34 Dispersal Zone of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2017**  
**New Brighton – 20:00 Hrs Friday 26th to 20:00 Hrs Sunday 28th June 2020**

Authority of order granted by Inspector Harrison of Wallasey Police Station.

Due to a recent increase in Criminal Damage, Crime and Anti-Social Behaviour in the enclosed boundaries of New Brighton a Dispersal Zone has been authorised. The Dispersal Zone will cover the area outlined below. The full outline of the Dispersal area can be found on the below map. This order will last for a period of **48 hours** – Any persons aged 10 or over, in a public place in this locality and has contributed or is likely to contribute to behaviour, which would cause members of the public in that locality, harassment alarm or distress may be directed to leave that area for a period of 48 hours.

Should a person who has previously been directed to leave the area return, an offence would be committed, which they may ultimately be arrested for.
