As you may know, the application by Morris Homes to build 217 houses on Acre Lane was due to be decided last night by councillors on the Planning Committee.

Many residents attended the meeting and two residents put forward the reasons for wanting the plan to be amended – not least because of the impact 217 houses will have on traffic on the roads around here.

More than 1,000 people signed petitions supporting the call for the plan to be changed.

Sadly, of the 13 councillors on the Planning Committee, only six supported the residents (four Conservative Councillors, a Liberal Democrat and a Green Party councillor).

All seven Labour councillors on the Committee voted to APPROVE the application as it is.

That means that Morris Homes can now go ahead with their development.

This is one of the reasons why I am standing to be the new councillor for our community - I believe local people should be given a bigger say on issues like this.
